St. Petersburg is among Top 10 European destinations and Top 25 destinations of the world according to Tripadvisor Traveller's choice.


Infrastructure of the city is constantly evolving. Besides the brand-new Passenger port of Saint Petersburg the airport terminal "Pulkovo" was also very recently commissioned and is already ensuring comfort and convenience of air passengers. For a quick trip to Moscow or Helsinki one can take the high-speed trains "Sapsan" and "Allegro".

During autumn and winter the spectacular transformation of the city's landscapes is even more enjoyable with the low prices on city tours and absence of crowds around the main attractions, making St. Petersburg the ultimate winter cruise destination.


Passenger port of Saint Petersburg is an active participant of the Baltic cruise ports' project on promoting winter cruises.

During the low season – from January 15th till April 30th and from October 1st till December 25th – the cost of infrastructure provision services at Passenger port of Saint Petersburg is reduced by 50%.




St. Petersburg, according to the magazine Cruise Insight, became the best cruise destination offering quality tourist programs for groups.

The main goal of the "Ports & Destinations Awards" contest is to evaluate ports and destinations in terms of port infrastructure development, quality of services and shore excursions for tourist groups, diversity of tourist programs for individual travelers. The winners are determined by the jury of Cruise Insight in a survey of cruise lines.









PLAN OF PASSENGER PORT OF SAINT PETERSBURG

4 Terminals

7 berths, including:

5 cruise berths

2 combined cruise and ferry berths

Helipad:

• The helipad is designed to receive helicopters of various types and with gross mass of up to 13 tons on a year-round basis

Parking areas:

• Parking space for **518** for cars and minibuses

Depth of the harbor- 10,7 meters

The total length of the berth line is 2171 meters

Depth of the access channel – 11 meters

- Parking space for **221** tourist buses
- The helipad meets all current transport safety requirements and is under constant surveillance

Design passenger turnover capacity – 2 million passengers per year, including cruise ship passengers – 1 217.8 thousands per year, ferry ships passengers – 790.4 thousands per year.

Passenger port of Saint Petersburg receives cruise and ferry ships with maximum length of **333** meters, width of up to **47** meters and draft of up to **8.8** meters.

SERVICES FOR SHIPS

Water bunkering

- Water supply capacity is up to 100 m³ per hour
- The port has separate water connection point on each berth
- The supplied water meets all necessary sanitary standards and requirements

Fuel and lubricants bunkering

• The port has a capacity for fuel bunkering from harbor waters and for bunkering with oil and lubricants from berth.

Garbage disposal and waste water collection

- Sewage system capacity is up to 100 m³ per hour
- The sewage connection points are mounted on all berths
- Dry garbage is received in specialized containers

Other services

The port provides gangways, gangway planks and forklifts for loading/unloading of luggage.

Each passenger spends on average 40 seconds to pass through the immigration control. Thus, with the existing amount of cabins it may take as little as 1 and a half hour for the passengers to disembark from the mid-size ship and to go on excursion.
